writing assessment covers - ttms - cumulative view of growth and self-evaluation; encouragement of risk taking and honest expression. decrease evaluation as negative burden for teacher and student by: marking all papers heavily for errors, making teacher a bottleneck; teacher editing paper, and only after completed, rather than student making
